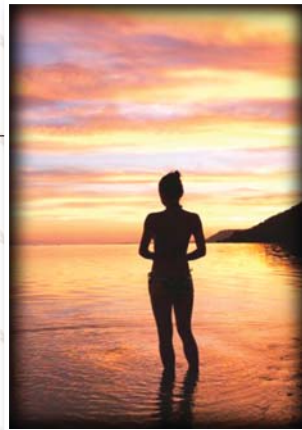

When she bought her home in Teakwood Village she was looking for an eastern exposure because the sun would rise in her front porch and get her creative juices running. The creative juices have been really running if the amount of wonderful works of art in her home is any example. What a Talent!

Gail came to Teakwood Village because of her best friend and next door neighbour Sade DesJardins. They have been life long friends and raised their children in Gladstone Michigan.

This multi-faceted person is not only a talented painter but also a successful business owner. She started her own business in 1972 in Marquette, Michigan. Her long-term goal was to own a business and be self-sufficient. This all came about when she was employed in an independent flower shop learning all aspects of the business. The business changed hands, and the man who bought it created his own competition when he let the staff of that old flower shop go. As she was leaving, she told him that she would start her own flower shop and would put him out of business in six months. That was all the encouragement she needed. For those of you who are getting ready to leave, have a safe trip and a healthy and fun summer.

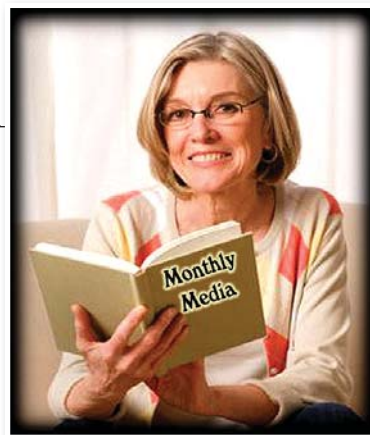
Remember to put away your outside items both big and small and make sure that the main office has a main contact number in case they need to reach you.
